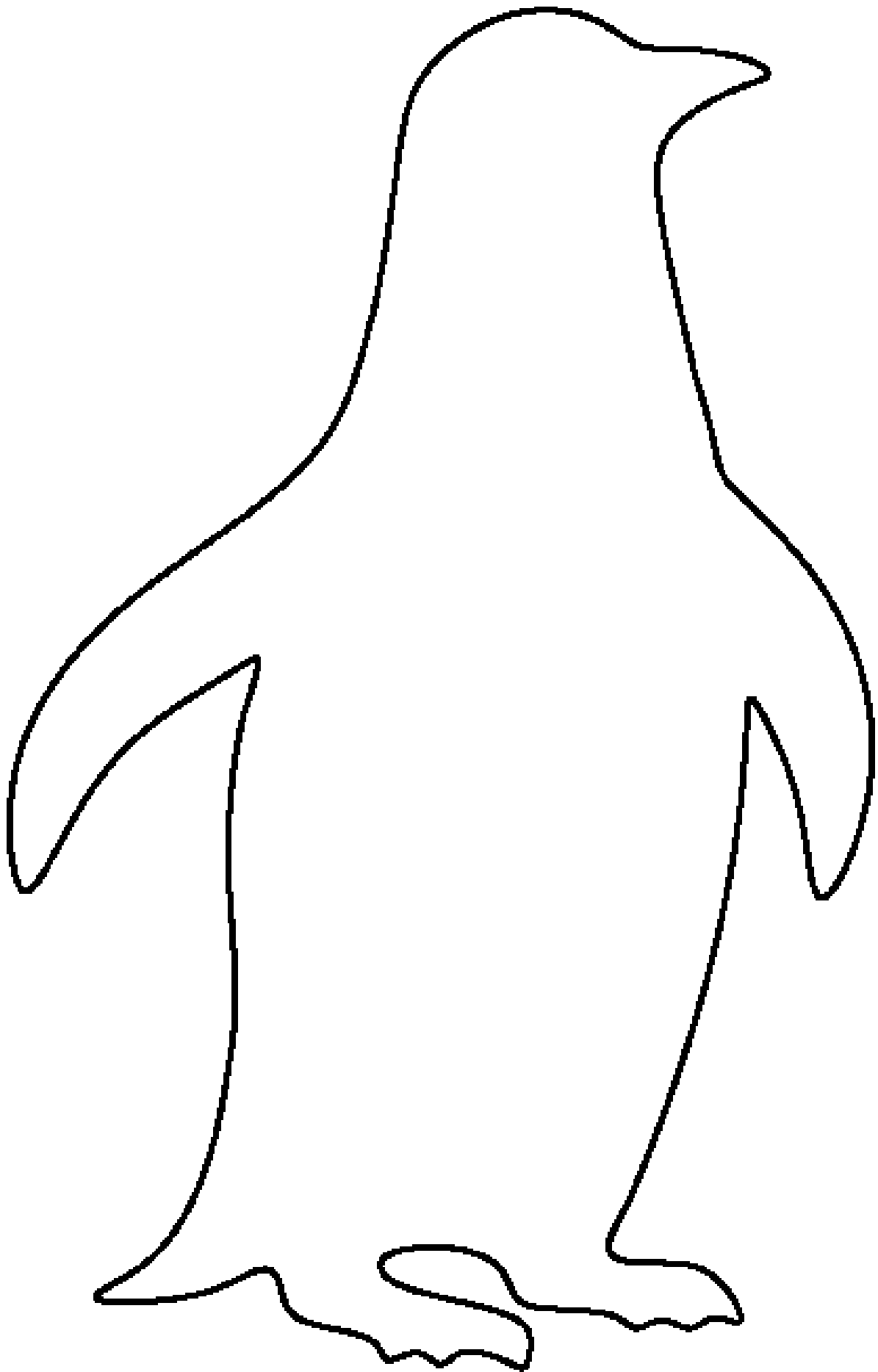




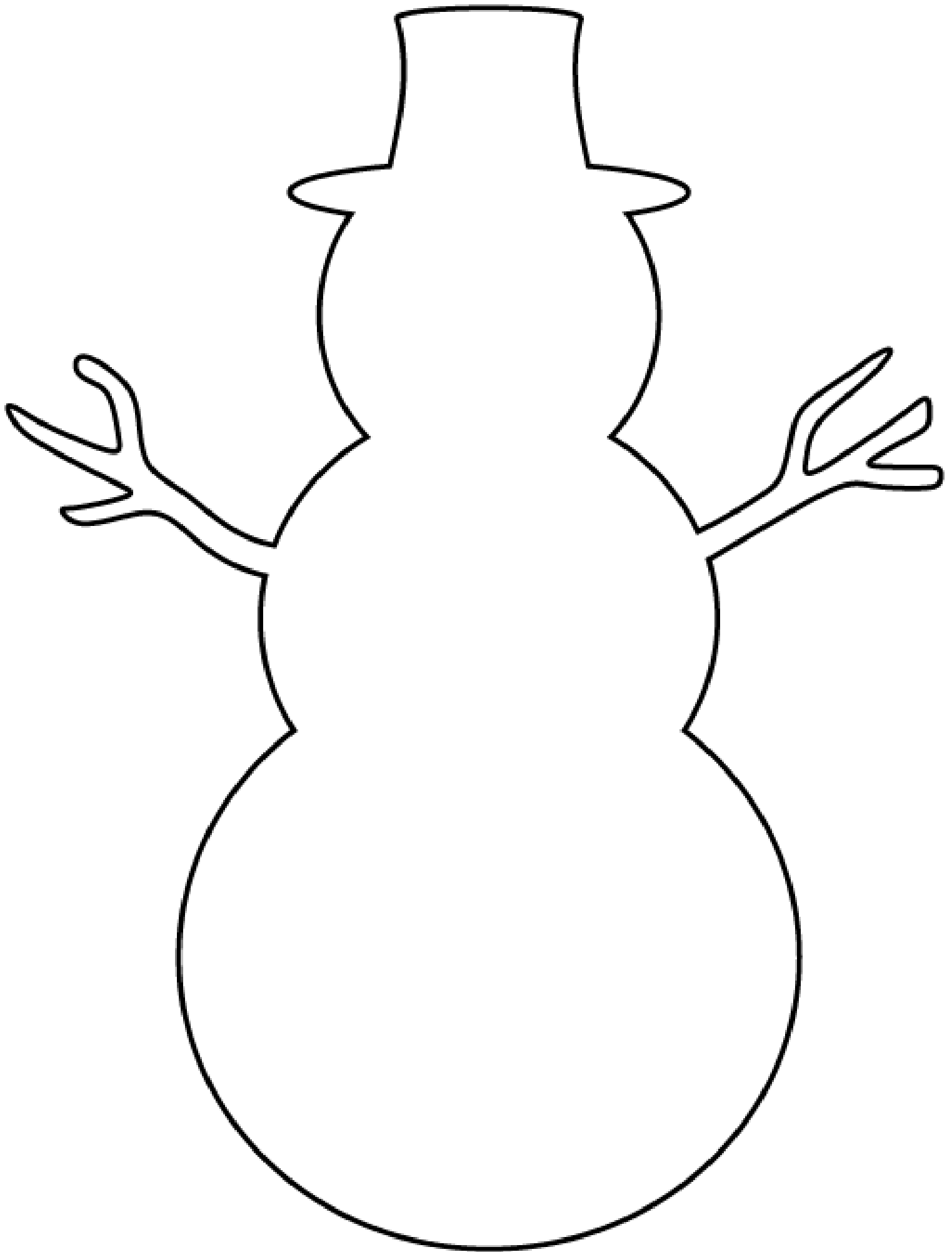
WINTER OUTLINES

A few ideas to inspire you with this printable:

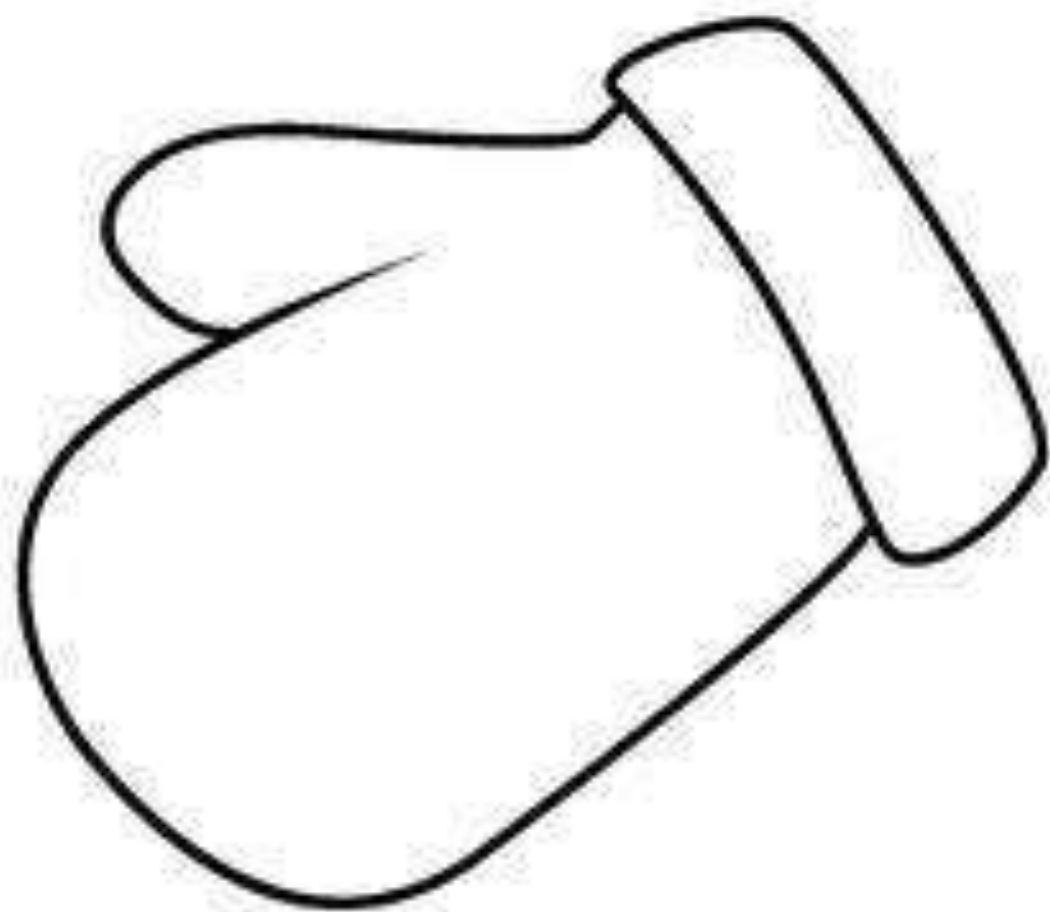
- Print them out and decorate them using your imagination
- Cut out shapes of paper of different colours/patterns/textures and stick them inside the outlines to make a collage. You could find different shapes on magazines or books to make it more interesting.
- Laminate them and decorate them with a whiteboard marker. You can wipe it off and do it again many times.
- Draw lines in them with a white crayon and then use a brush with coloured water to paint them and discover the patterns made with the white crayon.
- Paint them, cut them out and stick them on a coloured cardboard
- Call out parts of the picture and colours or patterns. The child has to follow the instructions to decorate the shapes (for example: penguin eyes blue, penguin belly red with dots, tree with love hearts lights, etc.)
- Draw lines inside the outlines to make squares and write different numbers or shapes in each square. Write on the side what colour goes with each number or shape. The child must match the colour with the correspondent number/shape.
